

# **POCANTICO HILLS 2010 SUMMER POOL & RECREATION PROGRAMS**

The Olympic-size pool, three diving boards, wading pool, picnic facilities, tennis courts, playground area and fields are open to all Pocantico Hills School District residents, full and part time employees and their families.

Pocantico Hills residents holding a valid recreation I.D. card have full access to the recreation facilities.

**DATES:** Saturday, May 29 – Monday August 31<sup>st</sup>.

**FEES:** Guest fees; \$5.00 per-visit.

**Long-term houseguests** residing in the district for 30 or more consecutive days between June 1 and August 31<sup>st</sup> have full access to the recreation facilities. Children who are long-term house guests of residents are welcome as well.

**Summer Rentals.** Individuals renting a home in the district for 30 or more consecutive days may purchase a season pass for \$175 per person. The fee for children is waived if the child is enrolled in the day camp program.

**NOTE:** Residents' children who are not living in the district are **not** considered Pocantico Hills residents.

## **GENERAL RULES**

No one will be admitted into the recreation area without proper identification. Identification cards must be shown when requested.

Permitting anyone to use your identification card will be sufficient cause for revoking it for the remainder of the season.

If you do not have a pool identification card, you must show a valid license or utility bill at the pool house, and have filled out a consensus form through the Main Office to receive an identification card.

## **DIVING RULES**

Only one bounce on the board is allowed. Only one person at a time is allowed on the board. The next person will wait until the first person reaches the poolside past the orange cone before he/she dives.

Lifeguards will set a rotation for low and high board.

No diving is allowed from any place other than from the boards unless the lifeguard gives permission.

Lifeguards reserve the right to ban any dive deemed unsafe.

Persons using the three-meter board shall swim straight to the lifeline at the end of the diving area.

## **Swim & Dive Team**

Open to children ages 6 - 18. Practices will be held Monday – Friday with times posted at the pool office. Swimmers must pass their deep water test in order to be on the team. Practice will start June 8<sup>th</sup> after school. Registration is needed by June 25<sup>th</sup> (the last day of school) All swimmer grades 3-6 will be picked up in cafeteria at 2:45pm by swim coaches. Additional information can be found on the school website, under the community tab on the left side of the page and summer recreation and swimming.

## **Group Swim Lessons**

Group lessons will be broken down into swimming ability to better serve the needs of each child. There will be two levels of instruction: beginner and intermediate. Registration forms and payment are needed at the time of sign up. There will be four sessions of lessons. Swimmers can sign up for as many sessions as they like. Registration forms are in the pool office. Session will begin the weeks of July 5<sup>th</sup>, July 12<sup>th</sup>, July 19<sup>th</sup> and July 26<sup>th</sup>.

**Fee:** \$30 per-session. Please make checks payable to Pocantico Hills CSD.

## **Private Swim Lessons**

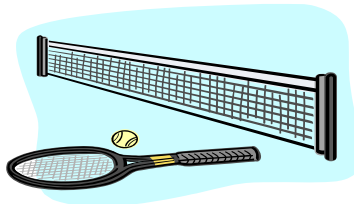

## **Pocantico Hills Tennis Courts**

The district has six courts that are available for play for residents and their guests.

No reservations are necessary. All guests must be accompanied by residents with valid ID cards.



## **POOL RULES**

All persons using the facility shall observe all rules posted in the recreation area.

**Smoking is strictly prohibited anywhere on the school grounds or in the pool area.**

**Alcoholic beverages are not permitted anywhere on the school property.**

All children will be required to pass a deep-water test before entering the middle section or diving area of the pool.

Any child who has not completed the third grade must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

All children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult after 5:00 pm.

No pets are allowed in the recreation area.

Children over the age of 5 are not permitted in the wading pool.

Swimmers using the lap lane will swim in the right half of the lane.

Children are permitted in the lap lane to swim laps only.

The east end of the pool is for adults only.

Guests must be accompanied by a resident who holds a valid identification card.

Residents & guests must sign in with attendant at desk.

Residents are responsible for the conduct of their guests.

Absolutely no horseplay or running will be permitted in the pool, on the deck, or in the recreation area.

No food or glass is permitted on the pool deck. Grassy picnic areas are available for all patrons.

Plastic containers will be permitted on the pool deck.

No balls, floats, or other toys are permitted on the pool deck or in the pool.

No flotation devices are permitted in the wading pool.

Bathing suits must be worn in the pool. No cutoff jeans are allowed.

Diapers are not permitted in the pool. Babies and small children should wear tight fitting bathing suits.

No gum is permitted anywhere in the pool or recreation area.

The float lines are for emergency use only.

Conversation with on duty lifeguards is prohibited.

***The pool rules are designed to provide a safe and enjoyable environment for all patrons. Lifeguards are trained to enforce the rules. Their orders must be obeyed. Questions can be brought to the attention of the directors. Continuous violations of any of the rules may result in ejection from the complex.***
