

DIRECTIONS

From the North

Take Route 9 South to Route 9A. Take Route 9A South to Route 117, Pleasantville-Tarrytown (left lane exit). Exit up ramp, turn right and follow Route 117 to junction at Route 448 (traffic light). Turn left at light onto Route 448. Proceed two miles. Look for amber caution lights indicating school ahead. The school will be on the left as you start down the hill. The school has three entrances. Turn left into Entrance #1, which is the third entrance. Bear right at fork and park in lot at the top of the hill.

From the South

Take Route 9A North to Route 117, Pleasantville-Tarrytown (left lane exit). Exit up ramp, turn left and follow Route 117 to junction at Route 448 (traffic light). Follow directions from above.

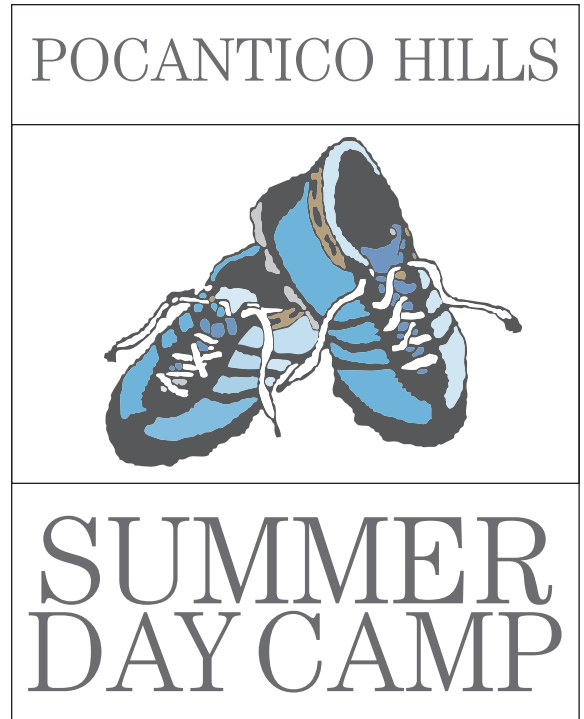

SUMMER AT OUR CAMP

The Pocantico Hills Day Camp is a fun, educational, rewarding and safe place for campers from Pre-K through Grade 8. It is operated by the Pocantico Hills Central School located in Sleepy Hollow, N.Y. The camp is situated in a beautiful setting and has full use of the school and its recreational facilities that include: expansive athletic fields, an Olympic-size swimming pool, a kiddie pool, six tennis courts and an outdoor basketball court. The camp also uses the school gymnasium, classrooms, art room, home economics room, wood shop and auditorium. Surrounding the facility are 2,000 acres of wooded property that are used for camp activities, such as nature and wilderness.

STAFF: This year's staff includes about 100 full-time counselors which enables us to have a camper-counselor ratio of about 1:4. The camp has one director and one assistant director. Our senior staff is made up of at least 20 teachers who run specialty areas and head grade-level groups. Our junior staff consists of college and high school students. We also expect about 15 Counselors in Training (CIT) this summer. A registered nurse is onsite at all times with full access to all medical records.

SWIMMING: Every camper is scheduled for swim lessons once a day and free swim at the end of the day. Lessons follow Red Cross guidelines and are a required part of the camp program. Safety is our first priority and we ensure excellent swimmer supervision through a bracelet monitoring system that identifies the swimming ability of every camper. Highly qualified and experienced adults run our swim program. Many of our staff members are Water Safety Instructor (WSI) certified.

- Athletics
- Swimming

- Crafts (wood shop, cooking, fun factory)
- Studio (drama, singing, dance, creative writing)

WE ALSO OFFER:

- Field trips at every grade level
- Weekly full-camp special events
- The Camp Show and the Annual Camp Fair
- Crazy time for older campers (a 30-minute period after lunch when campers are free to choose from a variety of activities).
- A Wilderness Program for older campers with trips and overnight campouts that include hiking, canoeing, tubing and campfire fun.
- The Teen Bike Trip – the culminating teen camp experience – a memorable trip that includes cycling, camping, cooking, and developing relationships and memories that last forever.
