We welcome students who are entering pre-kindergarten (must have turned 4 by July 1st) through rising ninth-graders. Rising 10th-graders can work as counselors-in-training and have the camp fee waived as compensation.

Campers are placed in one of three divisions: primary (pre-kindergarten through grade 2), intermediate (grades 3-6), and middle school (grade 7 and teens).

Our specialists enrich our camp offerings in the following areas: arts and crafts, primary athletics, secondary athletics, studio, culinary, wilderness and racket sports.

The camp provides transportation for in-district children for the regular camp day. Transportation is not provided for the change to early arrival and late pick-up programs.

The camp will be closed on July 4 in observance of Independence Day.
